Professor Amir H. Noormohammadi is a DVM graduate from Tehran University (Iran) in 1990. He completed his PhD study at the University of Melbourne (1997) on molecular pathogenesis of avian mycoplasmosis and since then has led various research projects on molecular diagnosis, epidemiology and control of avian pathogens. Amir has supervised more than 20 RHD students, managed major research projects during his academic carrier and has taught avian diseases to veterinary students for more than 20 years. Amir has authored over 130 scientific articles and several book chapters in the reference book Diseases of Poultry, MSD Veterinary Manual, and the OIE Manual of Diagnostic Tests and Vaccines for Terrestrial Animals. Amir is a registered veterinarian in Australia, and a member of the Australian & New Zealand College of Veterinary Scientists, and Avian Pathology (journal) editorial board. Amir is currently a Professor and Heads the Veterinary Anatomic Pathology and Avian Medicine groups.
