Dr. Isabel Gimeno is a Professor at the College of Veterinary Medicine of North Carolina State University. She obtained her DVM and PhD at the Complutense University of Madrid and spend several years doing research at the USDA-ARS Avian Disease Oncology Laboratory. She became a Diplomate of the American College of Poultry Veterinarians in 2002. Her research is focused on various aspects of Marek's disease including pathogenesis, diagnosis, and control. She has published 60 peer review papers, two books, and nine book chapters. She has presented her research in 98 key-note speaker talks and 100 presentations at scientific meetings. Dr. Gimeno has received several awards including the American Association of Avian pathologists Bayer-Snoeyenbos New Investigator Award (2008) and two P.P. Levine Award (2016 and 2017).
